The Adult Care Center of Central Virginia is excited to have been selected as one of the eight charities to receive proceeds from the 2017 Smith Mountain Lake Charity Home Tour! The dates for this year's tour are October 6, 7, and 8.

This marks the 27<sup>th</sup> year of the Smith Mountain Lake Charity Home Tour. Many people in our community would not have had access to food, clothing, and healthcare if the \$4 million that has been raised by the tour over the years had not been available.

We are looking for volunteers to staff the Adult Care Center's assigned home – the **Stacy-Nguyen Home** located at 228 Deerwood Place in the Mountain Shores Community on the Bedford County side of the Lake. This home will need a total of 140 volunteers for the weekend.

Volunteers are needed for five shifts lasting approximately four hours. The shifts are as follows:

- Friday, October 6: 9:15 am to 1:30 pm & 12:15 pm to 5:00 pm
- Saturday, October 7: 9:15 am to 1:30 pm & 12:15 pm to 5:00 pm
- Sunday, October 8: 12:15 pm to 5:00 pm

Volunteers are needed to (1) welcome patrons to the home; (2) hostess/guide patrons inside and outside of home; (3) attend traffic/parking; and (4) assist on the dock for patrons entering by water. *(Please know there are limited spaces available for traffic and assistance on the dock.)*
