

PARISH HEALTH

Be Safe in the Water!
Drowning is a leading cause of death for children. Ensure that every member of your family learns to swim. The skills of water competency are: able to enter the water, get a breath, stay afloat, change position, swim a distance then get out of the water safely. Additionally, restrict unattended access to pools, provide life jackets and keep children under close supervision. Know what to do in a water emergency—including how to help someone in trouble in the water safely, call for help and CPR.
