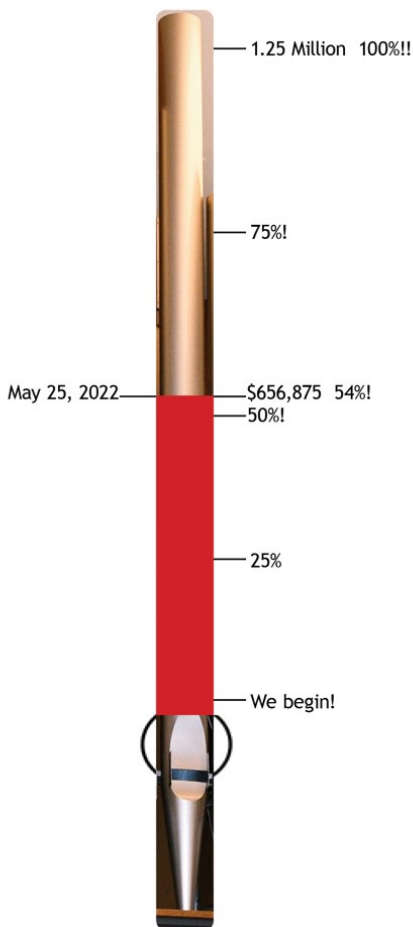

International **Scoliosis** Awareness Day is June 25. Scoliosis is not a disease; it is an abnormal curvature of the spine. In addition to the spine curving sideways, it also twists, making the ribs (which are attached to the spine) look uneven. The condition is most common in children between the ages of 10-15, although it can happen at any time in your life. Treatment for scoliosis depends on the severity of the condition. In 8 out of 10 cases, the cause is unknown.
